 DUTIES:
 Assists in all aspects of food preparation and distribution of large quantities of food; cleans, cuts, trims, grinds, chops and/or slices meats, vegetables, fruits and breads;

cleans, cuts, trims, grinds, chops and/or slices meats, vegetables, fruits and breads; opens containers, bags of frozen vegetables, fruits, dry goods, cereals; when assigned cooks, steams and/or assists cook in cooking vegetables, meat and other food; divides food into classroom size containers; loads, drives and distributes food and other supplies to all Head Start centers; unloads carts upon return; cleans, sanitizes containers and carts, work station and floors; washes tools and equipment; mops and sweeps kitchen; inspects and maintains vehicle for operating condition and safety; checks head lights, brake lights, tail lights, signal lights, mirrors, tires, gas gauge; fuels vehicles as needed; completes and/or ensures that sites complete assigned documentation. Performs other related duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Knowledge of: Kitchen sanitation, methods of care and cleaning of kitchen tools and equipment; basic safety procedures as applied to food preparation, basic math.

Ability to: observe kitchen safety and sanitation practices; understand and follow oral and written instructions; operate kitchen tools and equipment; exercise skills in organizing; ability to perform the physical duties of the job; practice good personal hygiene.

LICENSE & REQUIREMENTS:

Must possess valid California Driver's License and <u>must be at least 25 years old</u> at the time of appointment; H6 (DMV print out) must be attached to application for further consideration. Must possess a current food handler's card.

PHYSICAL & MENTAL DEMANDS:

The employee is regularly required to stand for long periods; bend, walk, stoop and crouch; use hands to finger, handle, feel; operate kitchen tools and equipment and to engage in repetitive movement; reach with hands and arms; taste, smell; drive a vehicle; lift or push up to 40 pounds. This job requires close vision, color vision and the ability to adjust focus; perform work under intensive deadlines; communicate orally; and interact with those encountered in the course of work.
